

ACCIDENT PREVENTION RULES



STOP!

This first step is **IMPORTANT!** Stopping first allows you the time to remember the rest of the safety instructions.



DON'T TOUCH!

Do not touch the gun! **DO NOT** pick it up to bring it to an adult or to show anyone else. A gun that is not touched or disturbed is unlikely to fire and cannot hurt you or anyone else.



RUN AWAY!

By running away, this will remove the temptation to touch the gun as well as reduce the danger that someone else might also pick it up which could cause it to fire.

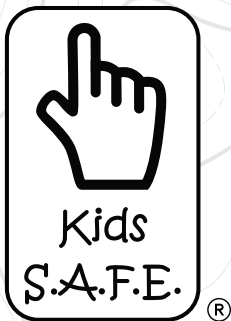


TELL A GROWN UP!

Tell an adult where you were and that you saw a gun and walked away. Let the adult determine what the best course of action should be.

SAFE GUN HANDLING RULES

1. Treat every gun as it were loaded.
2. Keep your muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
3. Finger straight and off of the trigger until your sights are on the target.
4. Make sure of your backstop and what is beyond.
